Public Service Vehicles (Accessible Information) Regulations 2023

Eligibility statement

To be eligible for the grant, an operator must operate vehicles in England, Scotland, or Wales and:

1. Have 20 or fewer vehicles.
 - a. not hold operating licences for more than 20 vehicles;
 - b. not be a subsidiary or sister company of an operator with 21 or more public service vehicles
2. An operator can apply for funding for up to 20 vehicles. Each vehicle must:
 - a. be a vehicle designed and constructed for the carriage of seated passengers only which is of category M2 or M3, as defined in Article 4 of Regulation 2018/858 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on the approval and market surveillance of motor vehicles and their trailers, and of systems, components and separate technical units intended for such vehicles;
 - b. be in use for a local service, as defined in the Transport Act 1985, provided under an agreement entered into, where a railway service has been temporarily interrupted, with the person who usually provides the railway service or with a person acting for or on behalf of the person who usually provides the railway service;
 - c. be designed to carry 17 or more seated passengers;

- d. not already provide both audible and visible information onboard for any of the following: (i) next stop, (ii) route or (iii) direction;
 - e. and met these requirements on 8 April 2024.
3. Applications must come directly from the operator which is applying for the funding.

1. organisation legal name
2. organisation type (e.g. limited company)
3. registered address
4. Charity Commission number (if applicable)
5. Companies House number (if applicable)
6. amount of funding required
7. where the funding will be spent
